RECORD AND IDENTIFICATION DIVISION

General identification work and record keeping in a law enforcement body are closely related. More efficiency is possible only if certain combinations of systems are effected. One record has a distinct bearing on another, and the answers to many perplexing questions are found by coordinating the work.

Complaint records such as burglary, robbery, murder and theft have a distinct connection with arrest records, as persons complained of, or whose acts result in such reports, are frequently arrested and brought to trial.

Missing persons are often located by connecting names in complaint and criminal alphabetical index file. This search frequently shows missing persons in jail, deceased, etc.

Information found in criminal index files also enables the department to serve misdemeanor and traffic warrants that otherwise might not be served.

CRIMINAL REGISTRATION

September 12, 1933 City Council passed Ordinance No. 73,013 requiring all persons previously convicted of certain types of crime to register with the Chief of Police, and to be fingerprinted and photographed.

Through this system the Police are informed of the local address of such persons. A registration receipt is mailed them and if an incorrect address is given, the receipt is returned through the Post Office and is used as evidence to secure conviction of Registration Ordinance violation.

Many subjects registering with the Department have later been arrested and convicted of other crimes. The Record and Identification Division compiles such violations and forwards them to concerned detectives for action. Approximately 403 subjects have registered since this ordinance became effective.

PASSPORT CLEARANCES

The practice of Immigration Authorities in directing persons to the Police Department to obtain Police Clearances before being issued passports, if applied universally would prevent attempts of fugitives-from-justice to leave the country, as many of these subjects are fingerprinted and "made" in our Bureau.

FINGERPRINT SECTION

On July 1, 1934 the Identification Section had 299,059 sets of fingerprints on file under the Henry System.

The personnel of the Fingerprint Section classify, search and file local and exchange prints, forwarding duplicate copies of local prints to the State Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation, Sacramento, and to the National Bureau at Washington, D.C. The Department also exchanges prints with several large cities through the United States.

15,515 local prints handled during year.
 6,995 of which were identified with past records.
 8,404 sets of prints received from "exchanges".
 3,404 of which were identified with previous records.
 25,296 total number of prints received from all sources.
 10,734 Grand Total of subjects identified with past records.
 4,471 calls to scenes of crime to investigate and photograph prints during past fiscal year.

At 1,378 addresses one or more prints were photographed and from these negatives a total of 4,678 prints were made, which were indexed and filed, later being checked with prints of suspects and others in the files. The result of this checking shows that 105 subjects were connected with a total of 139 crimes.
